We will build you a course with the fence height exceeding 1.0 m if you wish. For each round, the cost is \$25.00

Classes will run in accordance with USEF specifications. At least three (3) riders must compete in a class in order for points to count toward year end awards. With the exception of the Schooling Jumper classes above, a professional is welcome to ride unjudged. If enough entries warrant, the show management will create classes for the professionals at the desired fence height. If enough entries warrant, the show management will split Child/Adult Jumper into two sections—Low and High.

There will be membership forms for the TCRA and the CDHJC at the show for you to renew for the new show year!!!
