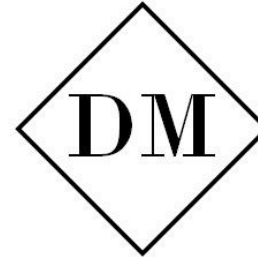

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein will be conducted and run in accordance with current USEF and CDHJC rules.
2. The management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entrance fees without being liable for compensation.
3. All riders must wear protective head gear when mounted while on Dutch Manor grounds.
4. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management and Dutch Manor Stable will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendants, animal, carriage or equipment at the show.
5. All entry blanks must be properly completed and signed by the owner and trainer before a number will be issued.
6. **Schooling fee of \$20.00 per horse.**
7. **EMT/Office fee of \$15.00 per horse.**
8. **Limited stalls available. \$30.00 per stall. Please call in advance to reserve**
9. A processing fee of \$35 shall be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.

DIRECTIONS:

FROM NORTH: Take Northway (Interstate 87) South to end. Turn right onto route 20 (West). Stable is approximately 4 miles on right.

FROM SOUTH: New York Thruway exit 24, follow signs to route 20. Turn right onto route 20 (West). Stable is approximately 4 miles on right.

All jumper classes will run in accordance with USEF specifications. At least three (3) riders must compete in a class in order for points to count toward year end awards. With the exception of the Schooling Jumper classes above, a professional is welcome to ride unjudged. If enough entries warrant, the show management will create classes for the professionals at the desired fence height. If enough entries warrant, the show management will split Child/Adult Jumper into two sections—Low and High. There will be membership forms for the CDHJC at the show for you to renew for the new show year!!!

\$250 GAMBLER'S CHOICE— Choose your own path to the jumps—as many as possible with each jump assigned a point value within the time limit. Full details available at the show. Each horse is only eligible to enter for one round. Entry fee \$50.
Payback—1st—\$75, 2nd—\$60, 3rd—\$50, 4th—\$25, 5th—\$15, 6th—\$10, 7th—\$10, 8th—\$5

Jumper table descriptions

Table II, Sec 2(b) - Immediate jump off—Clear first-round rides continue directly into a jump-off without leaving the ring.

Table II, Sec 2(d) - Similar to Power & Speed— a two phase class. The rider completes the first phase (power) and immediately continues to the second phase (speed) without leaving the ring, even if they have faults in the first phase.

Table IV— Optimum Time—The optimum time is 4 seconds under the time allowed. The horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

Available at each hunter height offered. All heights will be pinned as one class. You must compete in at least one hunter over fences class at the desired height to be eligible to enter the Open Hunter Derby. You should complete your Open Hunter Derby round at the conclusion of your hunter over fences classes prior to your equitation classes. Each horse is eligible for one entry of the derby. If multiple people are riding the same horse, the horse is only eligible to compete once in the derby. To be pinned at the end of the day.
