CDHJC EQUITATION FINALS

1. **UNJUDGED WARM-UP...open to Con Culkin and Symmes participants as well as 3' Horsemastership participants.** Fences will be at 2'9". Maximum of 2 rounds per entry (second round IF time permits). No professionals to ride. Horses may only be ridden by entered qualifiers.
\$15.00 per round

2. CON CULKIN ADULT MEDAL FINALS

Open to Adult Amateur members of the CDHJC who have acquired at least 15 points at CDHJC recognized horse shows in the Adult Equitation division. The class will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for those riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Fences not to exceed 3'. Winners of the Finals class may continue to ride in the class until they have won the Finals three (3) times, not necessarily consecutively.
Champion Cooler and 8 ribbons

Entry Fee \$50.00

3. RALPH P. SYMMES MEDAL FINALS

Open to all qualified riders (from current show year AND 2020) who have accumulated five (5) points in Symmes classes at recognized horse shows. The finals will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for those riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Fence height 3'.

4. **UNJUDGED WARM-UP...open to Mini-Medal and Masters Class participants as well as 2'6" Horsemastership participants.** Fences will be at 2'6". Maximum of 2 rounds per entry (second round IF time permits). Professionals may ride.
\$15.00 per round

5. MASTERS CLASS

Open to any former winner of the Ralph P. Symmes Medal Finals, the Con Culkin Adult Medal Finals, or the CDHJC Mini-Medal Final. Fences 2'6". Winners of this class may continue to compete in it.

Entry Fee \$50.00

6. CDHJC MINI-MEDAL FINAL

Open to current Adult Amateur and Junior members of the CDHJC who have accumulated at least fifteen (15) points in the Modified Children's/Adult Equitation division. Fence height shall not exceed 2'6". The course will not include any combinations. The class will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for those riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Those entering this class are not eligible for any other class in which the fence height exceeds 2'9" at the Finals show.

Rules & Regulations

Every class offered herein will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CDHJC rule book. All entries are post entries.

The management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return fee without being liable for compensation.

Riders will be properly attired for all classes. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds.

EVERYONE ON THE GROUNDS MUST BE MASKED AT ALL TIMES, MOUNTED OR ON FOOT.

There will be a posted order for all Finals classes.

All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management, Skidmore College, and the CDHJC will not be responsible for any accidents which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendants, animal, carriage, or equipment at the show.

All entry blanks must be properly completed, signed, and have an open check attached BEFORE numbers will be issued. NO exceptions.

A processing fee of \$30.00 shall be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.

All Junior riders MUST have a parent or trainer ON THE GROUNDS whenever riding. No Junior rider will be allowed to ride without a parent or trainer on the grounds, supervising them at all times.

All jumper classes will be run in accordance with CDHJC and USEF Jumper Specifications.

7. Horsemastership Participation Class

This class is available for Junior members of the CDHJC who wish to participate in the Horsemastership Program, but are not eligible or have not qualified for the Medal Finals. The score for this class will count for the Riding Phase of the Horsemastership Program. The class will run regardless of the number of entrants. This class will consist of one jumping round over an equitation type course. Riders may opt to ride one of the following heights: 2'0", 2'6", and 3'0." No combinations will be allowed, except at 3'0." In order to enter this class, participants must have submitted an entry for the Horsemastership Program Award. Riders must declare the height at which they will compete on the morning of the Equitation Finals. At the discretion of the show management, the class may be split by height to run with the Mini-Medal Final and Ralph Symmes Final.

8. UNJUDGED WARM-UP...open to those riders participating in the 2' to 2'3" Equitation Finals and the 2' Horsemastership participants. Fences will be at 2'. Maximum of 2 rounds per entry (second round IF time permits). Professionals may ride. **\$15.00 per round**

9. CDHJC 2' to 2'3" EQUITATION FINAL

Open to Adult Amateur and Junior members of the CDHJC who have accumulated at least fifteen (15) points in the CDHJC 2'3" Equitation Division or the CDHJC 2' Equitation division. Fence height 2' and 2'3"; participants who are qualified in both divisions must choose which height they will show in the Final. The course will not include any combinations. The class will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for those riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Those entering this class are not eligible to show in any other class in which the fence height exceeds 2'6" at this show.

10. Beginner Equitation Medal Finals

Open to Adult Amateur and Junior members of the CDHJC who have accumulated at least fifteen (15) points in the CDHJC Beginner Equitation division. Fence height will be crossrails. The course will not include any combinations. The class will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for those riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Those entering this class are not eligible to show in any other class at this show.

Entry fee \$50.00

Optimum Time Jumper Division

Championships not to count toward year end awards. Open to Junior or Adult Amateur riders. Fence height: .75 - .85 (2'5" – 2'9"). Horse and rider combinations entered in an Optimum Time Jumper class MAY show in CH/AD Jumper Low classes on the same day, but may NOT show in CH/AD Jumper High classes on the same day. All classes to be run in accordance with USEF Table IV (Sections 1 -2c) wherein classes are scored on faults as under Table II, however, all ties are broken on the basis of the Optimum Time. "Optimum Time" is defined as 4 seconds less than the time allowed for the course. For each class, a time allowed will be posted on the course plan. In the case of equality of faults, the horse/rider combination with the closest time to the optimum time (over and under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc. Local CDHJC shows offering Optimum Time Jumper classes for CDHJC points must offer at least two classes. A minimum of three riders must compete in order for points to count toward year end awards.

Specifications for classes : Open to any horse ridden by a Junior or Amateur member of the CDHJC. Final classes will be offered in BOTH the CDHJC Child/Adult Jumper Low and the CDHJC Child/Adult Jumper High Divisions. Horse must have accumulated one point in either division in order to compete at the Finals in that division. A horse that has accumulated at least one point in both the Low and the High divisions may only compete in ONE division at the Finals. The rider of said horse must declare at which level the horse will compete before the Finals classes begin. Formal attire required. USEF Table II, 2a.

17. **CDHJC Child/Adult Jumper Finals, 2'9" -3" or 3'6"**. Class will be split if entries warrant.
