**Location: Approximately: 15 miles from Queensbury,
17 miles from Saratoga, and 30 miles from Troy.**

Directions: When following GPS plug in 70 Stott Road. This is my house and farm address, the entrance for trailers is before my house and you will see the farm sign. Stott Rd is a dirt road.

From South: Take Northway to exit 14. Left onto Union Ave/9P towards Schuylerville. Slight left onto Meadow Brook Rd (GPS may also have you taking Gilbert or Henning Rd to 29). At the end of Meadowbrook, take left onto Staffords Bridge Rd. In approximately a mile, take right at light onto 29 towards Schuylerville. In approximately 7 miles take a right onto Broad St/Route 4 S/Route 32/Route 29. In approximately a quarter mile, take second left onto Ferry St. to follow Route 29. In approximately 4 miles, at roundabout in Greenwich, take the second exit onto Route 40 North. In approximately 6 miles, turn left onto McNeil Rd(landmark Zaymech Corporation building on right hand side right before the turn, Stoverly shop on left hand side AT turn) slow down going down the slight hill when you see Zaymech...with a trailer you will miss the turn if you don't slow down. In approximately a half mile, turn right on Stott Rd. Horse Show entrance right on the right side of the road.

Anyone coming from the Troy area, route 40 through Schaghticoke is the best way.

From North: Take Northway to exit 17N towards South Glens Falls. Approximately 2 miles, take a right onto Reynolds Rd/Route 197. In approximately 5 miles, take a right onto Route 4W/Route 197. In approximately half a mile, take a left onto Argyle St/Route 197. In approximately a quarter mile, take first right onto Route 197. In approximately 5 miles, Route 197 becomes Route 40. In approximately 2 miles (just past Locust Grove Smokehouse), take a right onto Lick Springs Rd. **Go past Stott Rd(long dirt road from this direction and uphill, want to avoid). Take left on McNeil. Left on Stott. Horse show on right.**

Entries

Pre-Entries required, deadline 7/23 by email by 5:00 PM. All entries must be signed before being issued a back number. Payment can be made the day of the show. Please email to Niki@ridgebrookfarms.com and cc to cdhjcstrait@gmail.com

Best way to email entries: Adobe Scan App on phone(free) take picture and email it to me. This app converts it to a printable PDF file like magic! OR you can scan it or fill within and email it back. Please do not take a picture and email me the picture, it is not printable. I will confirm that I have received. I apologize to those that had to redo entries at the last show. My email bounced about 30 back due to a storage issue.

Back numbers must be worn for schooling. Schooling will be limited to 4 horses in the ring at once.

Stables are welcome to set up pop up tents near trailers for shade.

Show ring will be in sand arena and warmup in grass arena. Rain plan will be more schooling breaks in sand arena. Lungeing only across way in roundpen.

Class Descriptions: Competitors in the Junior Hunter Seat Equitation/Children's Hunter divisions may not have reached their 18th birthday. The age of a junior on December 1, 2020 shall be maintained until November 30, 2021. Martingales prohibited in flat/under saddle classes unless otherwise stated (Beginner Equitation). A prize and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. All Champions will be awarded a prize.

All class entry fees \$25. Unjudged Schooling round \$15. Open schooling \$15 horse.

Please refer to the TCRA rulebook and CDHJC rulebook for descriptions of class rules. The rulebooks can be found on the organizations websites and at the secretary stand the day of the horse show.

34. RALPH P. SYMMES CLASS • Open to Junior Members of the CDHJC • Fences which will be 3'0". • In addition to the High Score Awards pointed classes, all member shows will be required to offer the Ralph P. Symmes Medal Class. • A show may elect to use the flat phase in addition to the fence class, but only on a 50/50 basis. • The entry fee

for this class will be the same as that for a regular open equitation class. • A minimum of six ribbons must be awarded. • A minimum of three (3) riders must complete the course in order for the class to be valid. • One (1) win or a total of five (5) points qualifies a rider for the Finals. Points are as follows: 1st=5pts., 2nd=3 pts., 3rd=2 pts., 4th=1 pt. • The Annual CDHJC Show may choose to offer multiple Symmes classes. • Riders may continue to ride in the Symmes Class after qualifying for the finals. • The Symmes Finals Medal Class may be won by an individual only once. • A final class will be held at a designated show for those riders who qualify. The finals will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for the riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. • Qualified riders will be sent an invitation to ride in this class and only those riders so invited will be eligible to ride.

Local TCRA and CDHJC rules apply. Please refer to the Rulebook.

Dogs must be on leashes at all times and must have current Rabies tag.

No smoking around exhibitors and spectators.

All riders must wear ASTM protective headgear. Proper attire is required for all classes.

A \$50 fee will be charged for any returned checks.

Cash or Check accepted for entry payment. Check only for any memberships made at the show.

All entry blanks must be signed and filled out properly before a back number is issued.

Classes may be split or combined at management's discretion according to local rules.

Unjudged warmup trip before each height open to professional/amateur/junior \$15 per horse/pony.

Management reserves the right to decline any entry and return entry fee without being liable for compensation.

Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor, guest, trainer, or spectator to leave if acting unsportsman like.

Scratches must be made with the Secretary prior to the start of the class in order for a refund of that class. Not at the ingate.

All entries accepted with the understanding that the management, Ridge Brook Farms, property owners, TCRA, CDHJC, will not be held responsible for any damage or accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, spectator, animal, personal property at the show.
