Route for All Horse Transport Vehicles & Large Trucks:

From Exit 12 I-87 from South: (8.3 miles)

- Head east towards NY-67 East.
- Proceed through the first and second roundabouts staying on NY 67 E.
- At the third roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay onto Dunning St.
- At the fourth roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Plains Rd/County Hwy-108.
- Turn right onto Route 9P/NY-9P.
- Turn right onto Lake Road/CR 76 and proceed to CR 75.
- Turn left on CR 75.
- Turn left onto NY 423 W and bear right onto Jack Halloran Rd.
- Turn slight right onto Brickhouse Rd.

PASSENGER CARS:

For Cars from Malta Exit 12 off I-87: (7.5 miles)

- Head east towards NY-67 East.

- Turn right onto County Route 70/County Hwy-70.
- Turn left onto Radar Rd.
- Radar Road turns right into Brickhouse Rd.

COVID Policy

No Spectators. Minors may have one adult/guardian with them.

EMT will be conducting temperature checks on way in. Please allow extra time to get in and parked.

Masks must be worn by all when not mounted. This will be enforced. Masks will not be penalized in the show ring if you choose to wear one when mounted.

Pre-Entries required, deadline Friday 10/9 by 5:00 PM. All entries must be signed before being issued a back number. Payment can be made the day of the show. Please call to scratch if you have an emergency last minute so you are not on the class sheet.

Back numbers must be worn for schooling. Schooling time will be limited. Please keep back numbers this year.

Ribbons and prizes will be awarded at the secretary stand upon check out this year.

Entries Due Friday by 5 PM. Time schedule will be posted Saturday by 5 PM. Management reserves the right to take away classes posted if they do not fill.

*Day stalls available for \$40. Overnight Stalls \$60. Horses may come Saturday after 3:00. Absolutely no riding or lungeing on Saturday. Just getting horse settled for the night and set up for following day. Stall counts to me by Friday 9th!

***It is very important not to lunge in any schooling or show ring on the performance footing. Only lunge in the designated lunge pad on the top of the 'hill'. Maps of the property can be found at the secretary stand and signage will be out marking the lunge area. Anyone lungeing in the riding/show rings will be unfortunately fined \$200. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.**

Class Descriptions

Please refer to the CDHJC rulebook for descriptions of class rules. The rulebooks can be found at cdhjc.org and at the secretary stand the day of the horse show.

Competitors in the Junior Hunter Seat Equitation/Children's Hunter divisions may not have reached their 18th birthday. The age of a junior on December 1, 2019 shall be maintained until November 30, 2020. Martingales prohibited in flat/under saddle classes unless otherwise stated (Beginner Equitation). A prize and six ribbons will be awarded in

all classes. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Also all Champions will be awarded a prize.

A \$50 fee will be charged for any returned checks.

Cash or Check accepted for entry payment. Check only for any memberships made at the show.

All entry blanks must be signed and filled out properly before a back number is issued.

Classes may be split or combined at management's discretion according to local rules.

Unjudged warmup trip before each height open to professional/amateur/junior \$15 per horse/pony.

Management reserves the right to decline any entry and return entry fee without being liable for compensation.

Scratches must be made with the Secretary prior to the start of the class in order for a refund of that class.

All entries accepted with the understanding that the management, Ridge Brook Farms, Southbound, property owners, CDHJC, will not be

held responsible for any damage or accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, spectator, animal, personal property at the show.
