1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WILL BE CONDUCTED and JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK.
2. The management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fees without being liable for compensation.
3. Riders will be neatly attired for all classes. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved protective headgear while riding.
4. Post entries will be accepted prior to the starting of the class and upon signature of exhibitor or his/her agent and/or trainer.
5. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management and SKIDMORE COLLEGE, the CDHJC, and the TCRA will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendants, animal, carriage or equipment at the show.
6. All entry blanks must be properly completed and signed by the owner and trainer BEFORE a number will be issued.
7. Management reserves the right to cancel any event that has fewer than 3 entries.
8. **Schooling: \$20.00 PER HORSE**
9. A processing fee of \$50 shall be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Entry fee for all classes = \$25 unless otherwise specified. Six ribbons presented in each class unless otherwise specified. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Fences to include brush, coop, post and rails, gates and oxers. Under saddle classes will be shown at a walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Martingales are prohibited in under saddle classes. Championship and Reserve Ribbons will be awarded. All divisions are open divisions unless otherwise indicated. These Derbies are open to all. To be eligible for this class, horses/ponies must have competed in both over fences class in their division. This class does count for CDHJC Year End points in the Derby category but does not count toward division championships presented at today's horse show. Each Derby will be run as a Hunt & Go.

Entry fee for class is \$40 with \$10 added back. Prize Money: 1st = 50%, 2nd = 20%, 3rd = 10%, 4th = 10%, 5th = 5%, 6th = 5%

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Ties of horses for other than first place shall be broken by the time taken on the course. Six ribbons awarded in each class. Classes will run in accordance with the USEF specifications. All jumper classes will run in accordance Table II, 2(b) except Optimum Time Jumpers. At least three (3) riders must compete in a class in order for points to count toward year end awards. Entry fee \$25 per class unless otherwise indicated.

OPTIMUM TIME JUMPERS

CDHJC Recognized. Open to Junior or Adult Amateur riders. Fence height: .70m (2'3"). Horse and rider combinations entered in an Optimum Time Jumper class MAY show in CH/AD Jumper Low classes on the same day. All classes to be run in accordance with USEF Table IV (Sections 1 -2c) wherein classes are scored on faults as under Table II, however, all ties are broken on the basis of the Optimum Time. "Optimum Time" is defined as 4 seconds less than the time allowed for the course. For each class, a time allowed will be posted on the course plan. In the case of equality of faults, the horse/rider combination with the closest time to the optimum time (over and under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.
